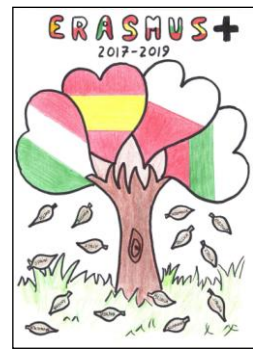

Do you teach Music in your school? Yes, we do

If so, Is it compulsory for students to study it? Yes, it is compulsory for students in Primary stage.

What age do students start studying Music? They start studying Music at 6 years old, when they are in 1st grade of Primary. So they have Music during all Primary stage.

How many hours per week do students have Music lessons? They have 1 hour per week.

What kind of contents do students learn in Music lessons?

They learn about rhythm, the notes and other parts for practice Music. The orchestra and different instruments, different kinds of Music, famous composers and singers. They also study the Music History.

Do students learn how to play any instrument in Music lessons? If so. Which instrument do they learn to play? Yes, they learn how to play the recorder since they are in 3rd grade of Primary (8 years old)

Is there a Music teacher with studies in Music? Yes there is a teacher who teaches Music and she has studies in Music.

Do you have extra lessons about Music in your school? No, there isn't any extra lessons about Music in my school. But many of our students go to the Conservatory of Music in their free time. They have to pass a very difficult exam to enter into the conservatory.

What instruments or kind of contents do they learn in these extra lessons? If they go to the Conservatory, students choose the instrument if their level in Music is enough for that instrument. We have students who are learning how to play the violin, the piano, the Spanish guitar, the drums...
